

Pastor's Ponderings

Shared Ministry way well be the future for First Presbyterian, Corona.

The Session has had preliminary discussion with the Session of Bethany Presbyterian Church of Rialto and is scheduling a day-long meeting in August to continue exploring the possibilities.

The goal would be to prepare a proposal that we can agree to and be approved by the Presbytery.

The advantages to FPC Corona would be:

Benefiting from the skills of a pastor who lives near Corona.

A pastor whose call is closer to full time (between the cooperating congregations) would likely have a longer term pastorate with us.

More ministry with the community can be maintained

Collaborative such as education, youth, seniors, etc. may strengthen the vitality of the congregations.

Collaboration strengthens the financial base for a pastoral call and ministry.

The issues would be:

Having a pastor who is committed to a cooperative model of ministry.

There must be an authentic spirit of cooperation between the congregations.

The Sunday worship schedule is a key. Worship will need to be early at one congregation (9:00?) and late at the other (11:00?)

My first churches operated in this way. Scotch Grove and Center Junction, Iowa had a long history of being served by the same pastor or student pastor. They each had their own facilities. Their Sessions were moderated by the same pastor but met separately. Worship at Scorch Grove was at 9:30 and Center Junction worshipped at 11. When I was a little late getting from Scotch Grove to Center Junction, an elder began the service. Occasional joint programs or projects were shared between the two.

I enjoyed my time driving the 50 miles to seminary while we lived in Center Junction. The reality was, and is, that a pastor really needs to live in or near the community in which the church is found. I hope that we can find a way to make such a shared ministry happen for Corona and a partner congregation for two.


