The first Sunday of October is World Communion Sunday. One of the joys of being part of our church family is the beautiful diversity of members who are indeed from east and west, north and south. This Sunday we will have a guest with us from the International Seminary.

International Theological Seminary (ITS), located in West Covina, is celebrating 40 years of service in their mission to: "Equip and train in the Reformed tradition teachers, community leaders, and pastors, who can help transform local communities into vibrant places of worship, mission, and justice." Their students come from various countries around the world, including India, Korea, Nigeria, Malawi, Kenya, Myanmar, Nepal, Tanzania, Cameroon, and China.
